Oregon has closed primary elections. This means that if you wish to vote for either the <u>Republican</u> or <u>Democratic</u> presidential candidates, you <u>must</u> be registered to vote with either the <u>Democratic</u> or <u>Republican</u> Party. If you are not registered with either major party, you will still be eligible to vote for measures and any non-partisan candidates offices in your voting district.
