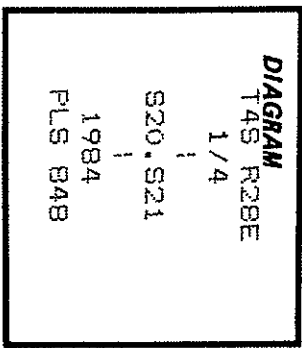


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

INDEX No. P-9

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established in 1873, by Zenas F. Moody, under General Land Office Contract No. 184. Surveyor General's Notes State: Set Stone 15x10x8 for 1/4 S Cor.



Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found, corner has been lost to road construction and logging activity.

No accessories originally established.

Set corner position at proportionate measure, between corners previously established 1/2 mi. North & South.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2-1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with 2-1/2" aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the **DIAGRAM**, SET 12" in the ground, & raised a mound of stone and earth around the pipe.

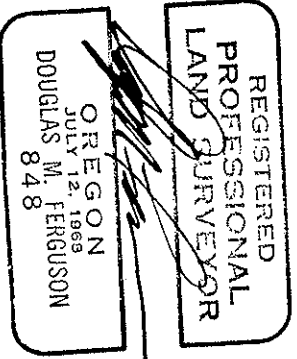
From which:

A Fir 10" dia. Bears, 569⁰W., 37.2 ft., scribed: 1/4 S20 BT

A Fir 10" dia. Bears, 540⁰E., 12.9 ft., scribed: 1/4 S21 BT

Measurements to trees taken with a metal tape and magnetic compass, with Declination set off 20 deg. East.

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing Tree Sign above blaze, and warning sign on back of each tree. Painted a 6" red band at breast ht. around each tree. Set steel fence post with warning sign, North 5 ft. from the corner.
