

History of original corner establishment:

Z.F. Moody under G.L.O. contract no. 184, dated Mar. 29, 1873, set a post in an earth mound from which:
A Fir, 12" dia., S30°E, 20 lks.
A Fir, 6" dia., N10°E, 3 lks.
E.W. Sanderson under G.L.O. contract no. 417, dated Aug. 24, 1881, found the post from which:
A Fir, 10" dia., S20°E, 22 lks..
A Fir, 9" dia., N15°E, 10 lks.

Leonard Carter, Public Land Surveyor, under G.L.O. special instructions, Group No. 228, dated Mar. 23, 1938, found a sandstone 16" x 10" x 5" marked $\frac{1}{4}$ C S on N. face. (I find no record of this stone.)

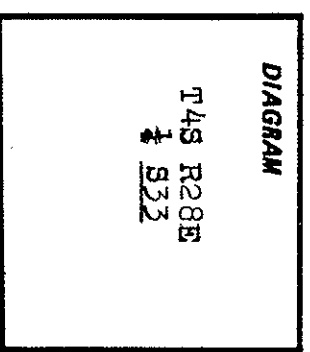
Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 1" Iron pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap marked:
From the corner: # S33
1938

A White Fir, 22" dia., N47°E, 56.0 ft.; with a healed blaze.
A White Fir snag, 15" dia., N14 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 68.0 ft.; with a healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I marked a new BT:
A White Fir, 27" dia., N69 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 81.0 ft.; marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S33 BT
BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags and "Land Survey Monument" signs. New BT has, additionally, an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.
Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 180E.
