

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1882 by Edward W. Sanderson, under General Land Office Contract No. 417. Surveyor General's records state:  
 Set sandstone 18x6x6 ins. 12 ins. in ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 on N face.  
 From which:  
 A pine 30 ins. dia. bears N65°E, 27 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 8T.  
 A pine 24 ins. dia. bears S45°E, 46 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 8T.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 18"x6"x6" sandstone set loosley in a mound of stone. No bearing trees fit record calls, however 2 trees with grown-over blazes face the stone. Apparently the trees were miscalled in the original notes.  
 Accepted sandstone as the 1/4 corner position.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

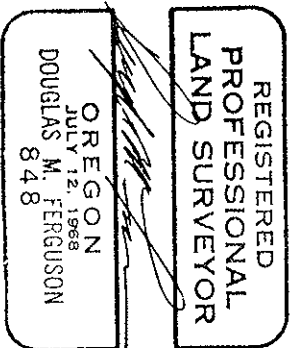
Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown on the diagram, set 16 inches in the ground. Set original stone North alongside pipe and placed a ring of stone around pipe.  
 From which:  
 A fir 8 in. dia. bears N20°W, 24.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S 11 8T.  
 A fir 15 in. dia. bears South 42.3 ft. scribed 1/4 S 14 8T.  
 Set a steel post with warning sign 5 ft. West from corner.  
 Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PLS 848 to each tree.  
 Painted red band around each tree.
