In 1938 Leonard Carter, Cadastral Engineer for the "General Land Office" performed a Dependent Resurvey, Those Notes State: Proportionate measure set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. (See DIAGRAM) from which:  
A white fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N72°E., 33 lks. mkd. 1/4 S4 BT  
A white fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N 5°W., 68 lks. mkd. 1/4 S5 BT

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 1" iron pipe with 2-1/2" brass cap, stamped as shown on the **DIAGRAM**, set 8" above the ground.

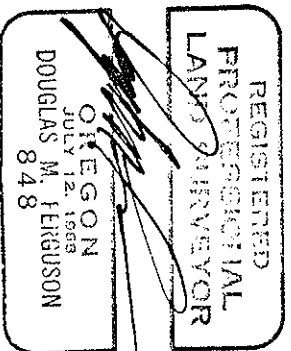
Found Fir 22" dia., live, in good condition, as scribed in the 1938 Resurvey, with blaze healed over Bears record; N72°E., 21.8 ft.,

Found Fir 20" dia., live, in good condition as scribed in the 1938 Resurvey, with blaze healed over Bears record, N 5°W., 44.9 ft.,

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Maintained Corner by setting a steel post with warning sign, North 2 ft. from the corner.

Maintained Accessories by nailing Bearing Tree signs above blazes and warning signs to the back of the original (1938) bearing trees and painting a 6" red band around each tree. Measurements to trees taken with a metal tape and magnetic compass, with Declination set off 20 deg. East.
