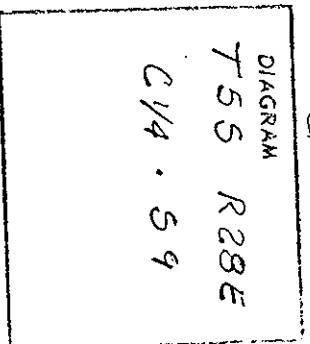


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
Unsurveyed - subdivided Section.

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

I set the monument described below at the point of intersection of the four found $\frac{1}{4}$'s of Section 9.

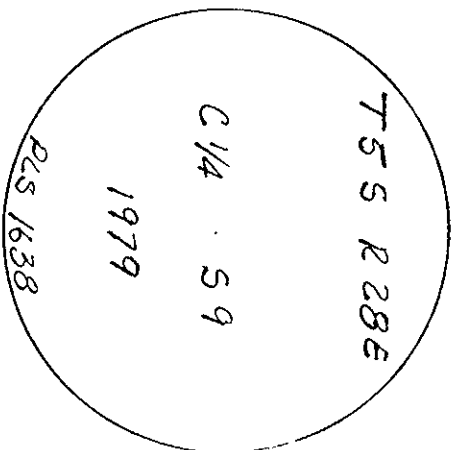
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position described above, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 26" in the ground, with a brass cap marked as shown:

From which I scribed BTs:

A tamarack 13" in diam. bears N 87° E $11\frac{3}{4}$ ' marked C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 T 5S R 28E BT with signs.
A lodgepole pine 16" in diam. bears S 27° W 20.4' marked C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 T 5S R 28E BT with signs.

I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 1638 to the BT blazes.
I set a steel fence post 5' North and 5' West.
I painted a red band around the BTs and face of scribe.
I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 21° East variation and measured a horizontal distance to the center of BTs.
This corner was set October 24, 1979.
