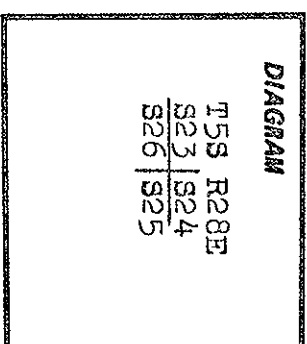


History of original corner establishment:

Leonard Carter, Public Land Surveyor, under G.L.O. Special Instructions, Group No. 228, dated Mar. 23, 1938, found a basalt stone 16"x 9"x 4" firmly set. At the corner point he set an iron post 3' long, 2" dia. with a brass cap mkd.:

T59 R28E
S23|S24
S26|S25
1938

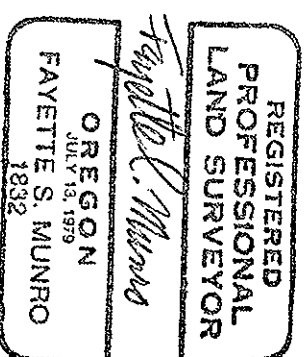


He marked new BTs:

- A Lodgepole Pine, 10" dia., N69°E, 72 lks.
- A Lodgepole Pine, 8" dia., S53°E, 60 lks.
- A Lodgepole Pine, 10" dia., S72°W, 73 lks.
- A Lodgepole Pine, 7" dia., N54°W, 14 lks.
