



NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to partition off a parcel of ground that the Morrow County School District No. R-1 wished to retain for playground purposes. We found and used pins set by Wayne Harris Co., Inc. on a survey for Dunkan and Pankey, dated May 16, 1975, a copy of which was obtained from Mrs. Pankey on February 24, 1982. The existing playground fence on the South side of the creek was used to control the East line of this partitioning.

Bearings are based upon the original plat bearings of Guld's and Adams Additions to the City of Heppner, Morrow County, Oregon.
