



**NARRATIVE**

The purpose of this survey was to partition a parcel of land belonging to McIntyre into three parcels. A portion of this land had previously been surveyed in April of 1961 for Earl Trudeau by Krumbain Engineering, Ltd., Morrow County Survey Records drawing no. C-445-K, however that parcel was never occupied and this survey replaces the Trudeau survey for pine set.

Bearings are based upon a survey by CH2M for the Corps of Engineers, dated February 1979, Morrow County Survey Records drawing no. C-276-K.

Bearings shown are grid.

- denotes 1/2 in. iron pipe with 2 in. Brass Cap set
- denotes aluminum cap found
- denotes monument found as noted
- denotes 1/2 in. iron pin with aluminum cap found and removed
- denotes 1/2 in. iron pin with aluminum cap set
- denotes bearing or distance of record from the Trudeau survey.
