NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to partition off a 9 acre ± parcel of land for Mr. Ihrke.
 Bearings were based on the survey drawing by H. Tamblin of the Original Subdivision of part of Sec. 24, T5N, R26E, dated May 3, 1935 and a survey by Krumbein for Bill Lottin, County Survey No. C-301-K, dated 5-12-80.
 Points found are as shown on Morrow County Surveyors Drwg. No. C-426-K. The Corps of Engineers points were set by the Corps of Engineers during work on the John Day project.
 We have been finding the original concrete monuments set by Worthington in 1905 and using them to control the breakdown of these sections in the Irrigor area.
