



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to locate the property lines and fence lines for Mr. Fisher, Gale, Bray and Enders. Bearings are based on the plat of Section 25, Township 5 North, Range 20 East, W.M., as filed by H. Tamblyn in 1936. It should be noted that the concrete monuments found are the original monuments which were set by Irving Washington in 1906 and are as shown on said Plat of Tamblyn. These monuments were used to lay out the property lines in a survey by Walter Cramer in 1980, Morrow County Surveyor's No. B-385-H, for Mr. Bray and Gale. Our survey confirms the location of the monuments that were set by Walter Cramer in that survey.
