



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to define the boundaries of and to divide into two parcels that tract of land in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 22, T4N, R 25E belonging to June and Wilber Akers.
 Control for the North and West line of this parcel were Brass Caps found at the N 1/4 C-C, N 1/4 and E 1/4 2/3 which were set for Arnold Braat by this firm, Morrow County Surveyor No. C-99-K.
 The Southern line was the West Extension Irrigation Canal as it existed on 8-85.
 Bearings based on the said Morrow County Surveyor No. C-99-K.
 The West Extension Irrigation District has only an easement through this section. They have a road and part of the canal occupying the South 25-30 feet of this parcel.
