



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to partition off a parcel of land for Starr from lands belonging to Mrs. Wagonblast.

The North line of this parcel is a portion of the South line of the Mormon Church parcel as shown on this firm's survey dated 6-15-84, Morrow Co. Surveyor No. C-677-K.

The East line of this parcel is the West right-of-way line of Tom Street.

The South line is the North line of that parcel of land belonging to John Ripple as shown on this firm's survey, Morrow Co. Surveyor No. B-667-K and also shown on said survey number C-677-K.

The West line is an extension of the West line of said Ripple parcel.

Control and bearing base are both from the Mormon Church survey drwg. No. C-677-K.
