



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to move the East line of that parcel described in M-17093 to James Farley, a distance of 10 feet to the East for a pending sale. Also to set the corners of said adjusted parcel for the construction of a building. I found a 1 1/2" inside diameter pipe about 1 foot below the surface at the Northwest corner of Block 1 of "Ayer's 4th Addition" and drove a 5/8" x 30" rebar inside of said pipe to 1" below the surface. A public sidewalk runs along the West side on this parcel, as shown. The above mentioned iron pipe was set by Turner in a 1917 survey of Block 1 and 2. I found the original of said map in Morrow County Abstract's office.
