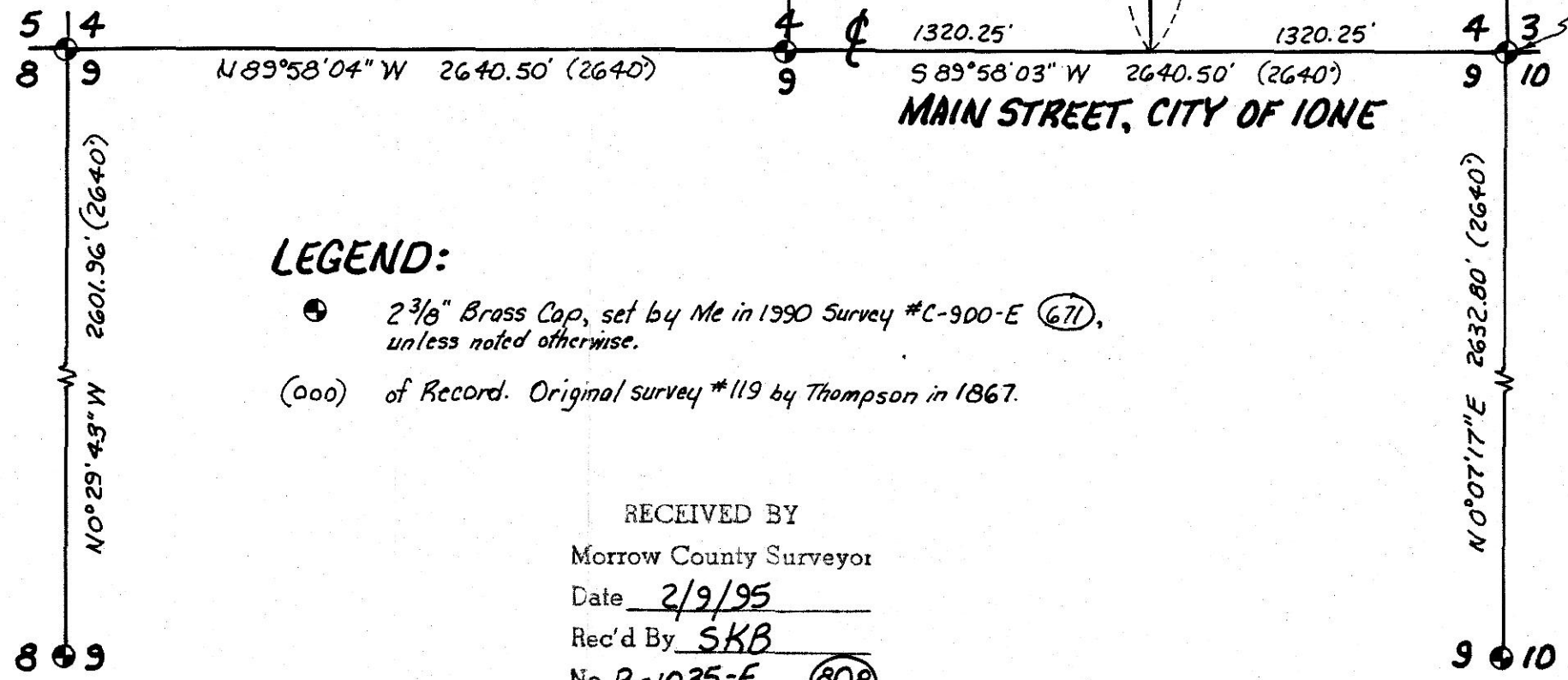
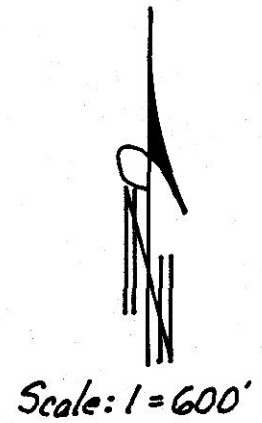


**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey is to establish the North-South Centerline of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4 so a fence can be built. I found the East Quarter corner of said Section 4. Also there is an old fence berm running along the North-South Centerline of said Southeast Quarter. Also there is a fairly new fence running along the North-South Centerline of Section 4. There is a 1" rebar at the Southeast 1/16 Cor. for which there is no record. I believe the old fence berm should be used as the North-South Centerline of the Southeast Quarter because it is reasonably close to being parallel with the East line of Section 4. The fence running along the North-South Centerline of Section 4 is fairly modern and I believe is less reliable for establishing the North-South lines than the old fence berm and the original corner.

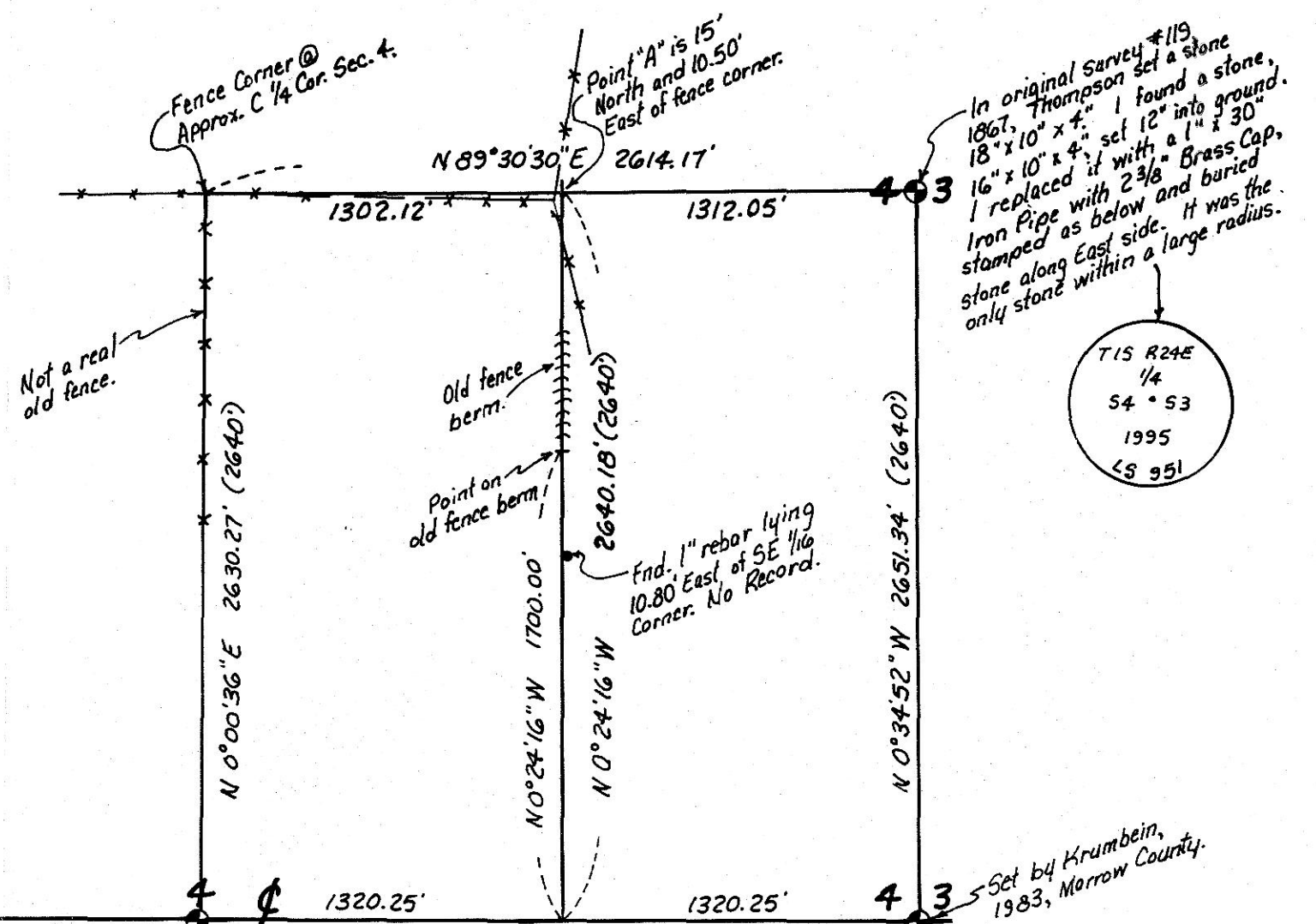

In original Survey #119, 1867, Thompson set a stone 18" x 10" x 4". I found a stone 16" x 10" x 4" set 12" into ground. I replaced it with a 1" x 30" Iron Pipe with 2 3/8" Brass Cap, stamped as below and buried stone along East side. It was the only stone within a large radius.
