CITY OF IRRIGON POST OFFICE SITE DESCRIPTION:

That portion of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 5 North, Range 26 East of the Willamette Meridian, Morrow County, Oregon, lying within the abandoned right of way of the Union Pacific Railroad as it was deeded to the City of Irrigon on M-15300, Morrow County Records, being described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the Northerly right of way line of said rallroad with the East right of way line of East Third Street and running; thence Easterly along said Northerly right of way line of said railroad along a 2766.19 foot radius curve to the left 320.20 feet (the chord of which bears N 85°47'48" E 320.02 feet) to a point on the East right of way line of East Fourth Street; thence 5 00°06'25" E along said East right of way line 181.42 feet to a point on the Northerly line of an easement granted to the State of Oregon by the Union Pacific Railroad for Highway # 730 recorded on M-13133 Morrow County Deed Records. Sald point lies 80 feet Southerly of the centerline of the abandoned rallroad when measured at right angles to sald centerline, thence Westerly along sald Northerly line along a 2946.19 foot radius curve to the right 69.21 feet (the chord of which bears: 5 83° 36'31" W 69.21 feet) to a point that lies 80 feet right of said railroad centerline at engineer's station 4178+00, thence N 86°25'07" W 250.72 feet to a point on the East right of way line of East Third Street which lies 50.00 feet south of the centerline of said abandoned railroad tracks; thence N 00°1110" W along said East right of way line of said East Third Street 150.01 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject to a slope easement for U.S. Highway # 730 over the South 10 feet of the East 69.21 feet of said parcel.

Also subject to an easement for an Irrigation altch over the North IC feet of the East 60 feet of said parcel.

Parcel described contains 1.23 acres, more or less.

## UTILITY NOTES:

WATER SERVICE: 4" PVC LINE SHOWN IN NORTH MAIN AVENUE IS PLOTTED FROM MAP PROVIDED BY CITY OF IRRIGON, ACCORDING TO KEITH WAITE, MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR, THE WATER PRESSURE IN THIS AREA IS 60 TO 65 PSI. SANITARY SEWER SERVICE: THIS PART OF THE CITY OF IRRIGON IS SERVED WITH SMALL DIAMETER (2") SEMER LATERALS AND COLLECTION TANKS. THE TANKS ARE PUMPED OUT AS NECESSARY. KIETH WAITE, MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR, HAS INDICATED THE CONNECTION POINT FOR THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE FACILITY WOULD BE AN EXISTING COLLECTION LATERAL LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 190 FEET NORTH OF NORTH MAIN (APPROXIMATE CONNECTION POINT BEARS N 32°58' E 304 FEET FROM NW CORNER OF POST OFFICE SITE). A SKETCH DRAWING OF THE PROPOSED CONNECTION POINT AND GROUND PROFILE FROM PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE IS ATTACHED SEPARATELY. OUR SURVEY WORK DID NOT INCLUDE RESEARCH INTO REQUIRED EASEMENTS (IF ANY) REQUIRED TO MAKE THE CONNECTION.

THERE ARE NO CURBS, GUTTERS OR SIDEWALKS OR STORM SEWERS IN THE SURVEY PROJECT AREA. NATURAL GAS SERVICE: SERVICE IS PROVIDED BY CASCADE NATURAL GAS CORPORATION, 1375 N. IST, HERMISTON, OREGON, 97838, PHONE (541) 567-5538. A 8" HIGH PRESSURE LINE (250 PSI). IS LOCATED PARTIALLY WITHIN THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE AND IN SOUTH MAIN AVENUE. PRELIMINARY TITLE REPORT INDICATES NO EASEMENT COVERING THAT PORTION OF THE HIGH PRESSURE GAS LINE WITHIN THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE BOUNDARY. THE 2" DISTRIBUTION LINE (PLASTIC), LOCATED IN EAST THIRD STREET AND NORTH MAIN AVENUE, HAS ABOUT 30 PSI

ELECTRIC SERVICE: SERVICE IS PROVIDED BY UMATILLA ELECTRIC CO-OPERATIVE, 750 WEST ELM AVENUE, HERMISTON, OREGON 97838, PHONE: (541) 567-6414. THERE IS PRESENTLY NO SERVICE TO THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE. A VECA FIELD ENGINEER WILL STAKE ROUTE TO PROVIDE SERVICE. SINGLE PHASE POWER IS AVAILABLE NEAR SITE CONTACT BRENDA OR GLENDA AT UECA

TELEPHONE SERVICE: U.S. WEST COMMUNICATIONS, PHONE: 1-800-603-6000. A FIBER OPTIC LINE IS LOCATED IN SOUTH MAIN-AVENUE (SHOWN). U.S. WEST LOCATORS INDICATED BY PAINT MARKS ON GROUND THERE ARE NO LINES WITHIN THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE BOUNDARY. BASED ON OBSERVED TELEPHONE PEDESTALS IN EAST THIRD AND NORTH MAIN, THERE WOULD APPEAR TO BE BURIED DISTRIBUTION LINES IN THESE STREETS U.S. WEST LOCATE SERVICE DID NOT LOCATE THE BURIED LINES IN THESE STREETS.

## NARRATIVE OF SURVEY:

THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AT THE REQUEST OF THE SCHEMMER ASSOCIATES INC., TO PROVIDE BOUNDARY SURVEY INFORMATION AND A TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY OF THE SITE PROPOSED FOR THE NEW IRRIGON, OREGON, POST OFFICE.

THE BOUNDARY OF THE 123 ACRE TRACT WAS RECENTLY SURVEYED AS SHOWN ON SURVEY NUMBER C-1076-E, MORROW COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS. THE PRESENT SURVEY ACCEPTS AND HOLDS THE PARCEL BOUNDARY MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED OR RECOVERED ON SURVEY NUMBER 6-1076-E, AND THE BOUNDING DIMENSIONS SHOWN ON THE PRESENT SURVEY ARE IDENTICAL WITH THOSE OF SURVEY NUMBER C-1076-E

THE SURVEY SITE DESCRIPTION CONTAINED ON THIS RECORD OF SURVEY IS RECITED FROM MORROW COUNTY ABSTRACT AND TITLE CO., INC., PRELIMINARY REPORT NUMBER 9437, DATED APRIL 3.

EAST FOURTH STREET, A UMIMPROVED 60 FOOT PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATED ON THE PLAT OF TOWN OF IRRIGON, RECORDED IN BOOK Q, PAGE 381, MORROW COUNTY RECORDS, IS CONTAINED WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF THE PROPOSED POST OFFICE SITE. ACCORDING TO THE CITY OF IRRIGON THIS RIGHT-OF-WAY IS TO BE VACATED WITH THE VACATION PROCESS BEGINNING AT THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING ON MAY 14, 1996.

THE SURVEY WAS MADE WITH A TWO PERSON CREW USING A SOKKIA SET 4B AUTOMATIC FIVE SECOND TOTAL STATION, TRAVERSE AND BOUNDARY MONUMENT TIES WERE MADE BY A COMBINATION OF RADIAL TIES AND CLOSED TRAVERSES BOUNDARY MONUMENT TIES WERE VERIFIED BY SEPARATE OBSERVATIONS, TOPOGRAPHY MEASUREMENTS FOR CONTOUR MAPPING WERE MADE BY TRIGONOMETRIC LEVELS. DIFFERENTIAL LEVELING METHODS WERE USED TO TRANSFER THE ELEVATION FROM NGS BENCH MARK NUMBER V-640 TO THE SURVEY SITE.
