

↓ At the quarter section corner between sections 27 & 28 Tp. 4 S. R.
28 E. N. M.

Find the original quarter section corner stake scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S. in
a decayed condition - rotted off and fallen down with no bearing trees
to be found.

Planted a new stake, in the old stake hole, 4x4 inches 5 ft long
 $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet out of ground and scribed it $\frac{1}{4}$ S. C.S. from which

- a tamarack 20 in. in diam. bears N. 55 lks,
- a red fir 22 in. in diam. bears N. 82° W. 57 lks,
- a tamarack 24 in. in diam. bears N. 85° E. 83 lks.
- a black pine 8 " " " " S. 17° W. 104 "
