

At the corner to townships 27³ north ranges 22⁴ + 23 east, I find ✓ the old original government stake lying on the ground and the mound of rocks poorly preserved, yet enough remaining together with the testimony of Sox Morgan, E. J. Fairhurst and Robert Wilson to identify the locus of the corner beyond any question. To more permanently mark this corner I cut a cross + on bed-rock 7 lks. N. 18° E. and also B.R. for bearing rock and built a mound of rocks 30 in. in diameter 24 in. high.

From thence I run west and at 160.03 chains intersect N. + S. line 10 lks. south of sec. corner at which I find the point of original charred stake which is in Billiam County, but more fully confirms the location of the last above township corner.
