

At the S.E. cor sec. 3 T₁, 5 S, R. 26 E. find rock 20x14x8 and marked with four straight marks on one face and the remains of stone mound. Reset the marked rock and rebuilt the stone mound in the identical spot of the original situs or location. Made four references of rocks 10 links dist. from corner and 6 in. below surface, the bed rock not permitting a deeper deposit, N.W. marked with Δ triangle; N.E. +; S.E. H; S.W. C.S. All to more permanently mark the corner to secs. 2, 3, 10 & 11 T₁, 5 S, R. 26 E. N.W. Running south from this corner at 11.55 ch. Yellow Pine tree 20 in. diam. blazed for line tree.
