

Andrew Reamy - Survey.

Commenced at center sec. 24 Tp. 1 S. R. 25 E. Var $21^{\circ}-46' E$.

Thence south, 40.22 ch. intersect E & W. line 3 lks N. of $\frac{1}{4}$ corner.

Dug and found bottom of charred stake - balm stake - char showing very plainly. Thence south 40 ch. Set rock for center corner to see, $25-15-25 E$. rock $16 \times 12 \times 7$ marked C.S. charcoal deposit underneath alongside rock marked C set by Davis & Reamy previously.

$S. 89^{\circ}-45' E$. 20 ch. set rock $10 \times 10 \times 4$ marked C.S. for Davis N.E. corner. $S. 89^{\circ}-45' E$. 20 ch. Found rock $20 \times 8 \times 4$. lying on ground.

Reestablished this corner by the rules of General Land Office.
