

W. A. Wilcox - Survey

Commencing at the corner to Secs. 1, 2, 11 & 12 T₄ S. R. 28 E. W. 1/4, which is marked by a rock firmly set in the ground having one notch on the E & one on the N. side and being 20 ft. N. of wagon track in county road up Butter Creek and N. $41^{\circ}-10'$ E. from Vincent's house. Thence South. 40.06 ch. a mound and rocks and government rock marked 1/4 on surface 80.10 ch. the corner to Secs. 11, 12, 13 & 14. Returned to 1/4 corner & reset rock and witnessed it. At 60 ch. South ran

East (having set a rock at 60 ch for Wilcox's S. W. corner) 20 ch. Set
rock in rye field for Wilcox's extreme S. E. corner - variation of needle
changed $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ to left while running 20 ch. South, Needle uncertain.
