

## J. M. Hayes - Survey

Commenced at  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner on W. side sec. 13 T<sub>4</sub>S. R. 26 E. N. M.  
Thence S.  $89^{\circ}52'E$ . 20 ch. South 20 ch. This goes across Ray Creek 1 ch.  
Set stakes on line at creek. Set stakes on line E from this corner.

Commenced again at  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between secs. 13 & 14 T<sub>4</sub>S. R. 26 E. and  
ran south to the creek to prove the location of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, and found  
the creek at 12 ch. as per field notes. This is one corner along Rhea Creek  
that appears not to have been monkeyed with, and the vacant land does  
not extend into Hayes's place to any injurious extent.
